We are planning to recruit 500 participants for this survey. This study will address the critical gap in knowledge on the experiences of diverse NPs to improve their job satisfaction and retention.

Who is eligible to participate?

- NPs who are currently working in primary care settings in the US
- 2 years or more of work experience in primary care advanced practice

Procedures: You are asked to complete a 15–20-minute, anonymous, online survey. The survey questions are about your job satisfaction, intent to leave, workplace environment, and professional support in your practice. The survey will not ask your name or any identifying information. Your responses will be kept confidential. At the end of the survey, you have the option of receiving a \$15 gift card.
