- January 16, 2025, the Senate read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance.
- January 14, 2025, The House of Representatives referred to the House Committee on Ways and Means.

Summary: To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to create a tax credit for nurse preceptors.

P&A Committee Insights:

- \$2000 tax credit.
