- STUDENT**

- EMERITUS**
Nurse at least 62 years of age, no longer employed full-time in nursing.
- INTERNATIONAL**
Nurse licensed in their country of origin who does not reside in the United States or its jurisdictions.
- NURSING AFFILIATE**
Unlicensed healthcare personnel, such as CNAs, medical assistants, technicians, etc.
- AFFILIATE**
Individual outside of other categories interested in supporting NAHN's mission.
- CORPORATE**
Organization or company interested in supporting NAHN's mission.
- GROUP**
Groups of 25 or more individuals who would like to join NAHN at a special rate.

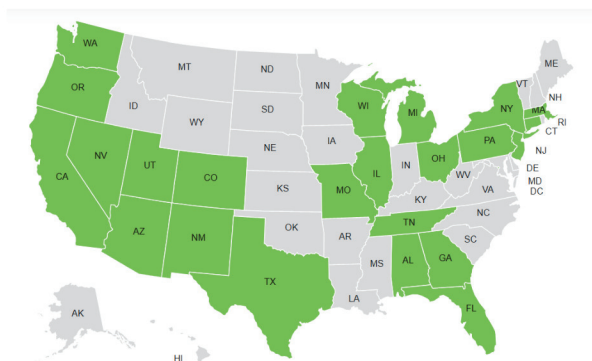
